## Film Companies Flock to L.A. Center Studios

**L**os Angeles Center Studios last week signed six long-term office leases totaling 31,000 square feet. New to the City West site are **AMP Filmworks**, **Hollywood Paws** and the entertainment arm of **Enterprise Rent-a-Car**. **Maya Cinemas/Esparza-Katz Productions**, **Delfino Entertainment** and **Gutz Film**, already located on the lot, extended their short-term leases. **Josh Rubel**, a spokesman for the studio, said the space became available when production crews stopped using the site's 12-story office tower — long known as the Unocal building — for filming. The three-block studio complex with six soundstages and 450,000 square feet of office space opened in 2000. It is bounded by Boylston, Fourth, Sixth and Bixel streets.
