

# EIDC moving its headquarters

The Entertainment Industry Development Corp. has signed a 10-year lease for 13,000 square feet at Los Angeles Center Studios and will move from its longtime Hollywood HQ by the end of the year.

The EIDC, which facilitates film production permitting on public property in Los Angeles, will occupy the eighth floor of the Tower building.

The Los Angeles Center Studios, just west of downtown, occupies the former headquarters of Unocal Corp. In addition to the EIDC, Promotional Partners, Creative Kingdom and Mice Creative have signed five-year leases at the studio in the last quarter.

Other tenants at the site include Maya Cinemas, Esparza-Katz Prods., CBS show “Numbers” and Blue Collar TV. — **Dave McNary**
